VII Bavarian Open Mixed Touch Championship

At the moment, there are 4 teams taking part in this tournament: Touch Muenchen1 and 2, Cologne/Heidelberg and Zurich Geezers, plus pool players from Frankfurt and Berlin. We are still waiting for confirmation on how many pool players we will have to see whether we can form a 5th team, or they will be assigned to some of the teams. Games will be of two halves of 15 minutes, 3-minute half-time break (with change of ends). 12 minutes between matches. Each team is to field a minimum of 3 ladies at all times. Teams fielding less than three ladies at any time will be penalised one touchdown per absent lady per half. In the event of a drawn match in the knockout stages, the match will then go to a drop-off. If a team is unable to field at least two ladies at the beginning of the drop-off, they will forfeit the match (it is a mixed competition after all).

Team Delegates' Meeting

Final referee and player's pool allocations, draw, instructions for the day will be given here.

- Finalise any outstanding payments
- Ensure their team supply referees to their teams allocated games

Refereeing

Refereeing is carried out by a limited number of full time referees and player referees at the tournament. In order to spread refereeing evenly among teams, we utilise a duty refereeing system. All teams will be allocated an even number of game/s for which they need to supply referees. Teams need to supply a minimum of 3 people to be available to referee.

We use triple refereeing whenever possible to minimise the workload on player referees and also maximise the referee coaching/assessment opportunities for referees. A final refereeing roster will be given to team delegates at the delegates meeting. Referees, please bring your whistles and a white t-shirt.

Food

Players will receive fruit, light bar-snack, a sandwich (cheese or ham) provided by Gaststätte Friends & More. Please bring your water bottles with you.

Location

To travel to TSV Trudering, catch the S4 S-Bahn (direction Grafing/Ebersberg) from Hauptbahnhof at 07:39 am arriving at Trudering Bahnhof at 07:56 am. Then catch bus 194 (direction Nauestrasse) from Trudering Bahnhof to Batchkaststrasse at 08:01 am. The bus trip is five minutes and Batchkaststrasse bus stop is right in front of TSV-Trudering. There is only a three minute transfer time between some S-bahns and buses so you have to go directly to the correct bus stop. A map of Trudering station can be found here <http://efa.mvv-muenchen.de/mvv/mvv/trudering.pdf> Trudering is in the same ticket zone as central Munich. A "1 Zone" ticket from central Munich to Batschkaststrasse (valid on S- bahn and on buses) costs € 2.50 per person.

A group day ticket for five people (known as a "Partner Tageskarte Innenraum") costs € 9.80. This gives five people unlimited travel on all public transport on one day in central Munich and is better value.

Tickets are purchased from the blue machines at S-bahn stations, or on buses. You must validate your ticket by stamping it in one of the small blue boxes before travelling.

1.1 "Touch München e.V. shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligations with respect to the provision of suitable facilities for the duration of the 7th Bavarian Open touch rugby tournament scheduled to take place on 6 August 2011 in Munich, Germany (the "Tournament"), where such failure is as a result of Acts of Nature (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, terrorist activities, nationalisation, government sanction, blockage, embargo, labour dispute, strike, lockout or interruption or failure of electricity service (a "Force Majeure")."

1.2 "In the event of a Force Majeure, Touch München e.V. shall be entitled to withhold such amounts of the team and players fees as it requires to satisfy all costs and expenses of whatsoever nature which have been incurred by Touch München e.V. in organising, setting up, hosting and arranging the Tournament and all registered teams shall be liable to the full extent of participation in the Tournament as if such Force Majeure had not occurred."

1.3 "Any surplus amounts received after application in accordance with 1.2 above, shall be rebated to each registered team on a pro rata basis"

1.4 "The foregoing is subject to the overriding principal that Touch München e.V. shall not be entitled to profit, be financially incentivised or retain surplus proceeds as a result of such Force Majeure to an extent beyond that contemplated in 1.2 above."
